

Papers Submission:

REGULAR PAPERS: All papers must be written in English and should describe original work. The length of the paper is limited to a maximum of 6 pages (in the standard IEEE conference double column format). **Registered and presented regular papers will be submitted for inclusion into IEEE Xplore as well as other Abstracting and Indexing (A&I) databases.**

SHORT PAPERS (Work-in-Progress / WiP): The length of WiP paper is limited to a **maximum of 3 pages** with no optional appendix in IEEE Xplore. At most 6 references can be included. Accepted short papers will be included in a volume of local proceedings.
